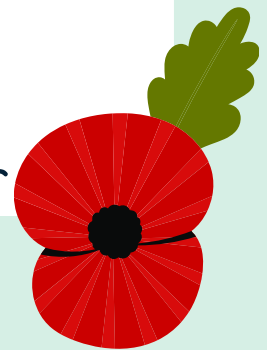

Procedures for End of Day

Reminder about bussing and pick ups
