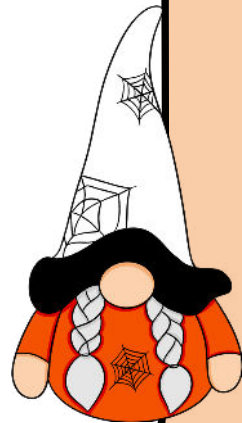

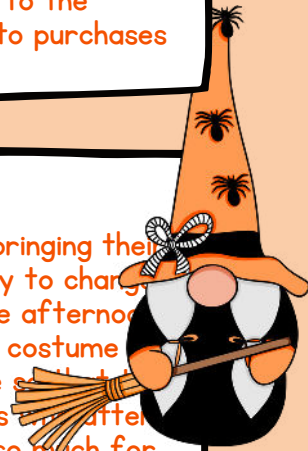
Picture Day
