#### 7. New Business

#### **7.1.1 Scouts**

#### 7.1.2 Cadets

Update: The Cadets will rent the 2 basement gyms, a section of the garage and 2 office spaces in the basement for the price of \$8000 plus tax. School agreed to absorb the cost of any weekend caretaking fees (only 3-5 weekends are anticipated per year)

It was made very clear to the cadets that any LES activity supersedes their activities. They will have absolutely no access to any classrooms. Scouts will have no access to the school unless there is a staff member in the building. They will not be given an alarm code or keys.

This does not need to be approved as it was already approved.

### 7.2. Anti-Bullying/Anti-Violence Policy (ABAV)

The Our School Survey is underway for students in grades 4 through 6. The survey must be completed by October 31, 2024.

The 2024-2025 ABAV project should be ready to approve during the November Governing Board meeting.

#### 7.3. Budget

The October Budget Report was shared with the Governing Board prior to the meeting.

The amounts seem to be high, however it is the beginning of the school year and not all school fees have been paid, to be able to balance some of the budgets.

The Daycare funding has not been received.

Up until now the money from fundraisers has been very informal. Ms. Noble is working on a fundraising form to better clarify the goal and purpose of each fundraiser at LES. This will be presented to the Governing Board one it has been completed.







# 7.4. Educational Project

In June 2024, the action plan for L.E.S' Educational project was approved. It was submitted and some edits were recommended. They are being made.

The Action Plan is being implemented.

From our 3 objectives the following have been put into place:

- Teachers have common preparation periods to be able to work collaboratively on student success
- Commitment to quality communication between stakeholders to facilitate student success
- Restructuring of adult supervision on the playground
- Leadership students are going to be trained to help with playground safety
- Social emotional learning opportunities continue to be offered in class and with our Special Education Technician.

### 7.5.1 Grade 6 Trip to Arundel

This Grade 6 fieldtrip to Arundel is to promote leadership development. This trip aims to enhance cooperation and leadership skills among our oldest students for use in school activities throughout the year.

This outing includes all grade 6 students, not just the leadership students.

For teachers, this falls under an ECA, as they are not teaching the leadership skills in their daily classrooms.

The fieldtrip is to be held on November 4 at the cost of \$770.47 for the busing. This will be paid from the 15014 measures.

The Cost of busing for this trip is: \$967.25 which will be paid from measure 15014 (Formerly Secondary Aide). Parents will be asked to donate some food items to help bring down the cost of food (snacks and breakfast items). Supper will be provided by LES.
